PERSONAL INTERVIEWS AND SITE VISITS:

A personal interview and site visit extends for the better part of one day, and routinely involves meeting with the Training Director, at least two or three members of the Internship Selection Committee, and at least one current intern. For our site visits, the Selection Committee tries to assure that applicants have sufficient time to properly evaluate how this program might meet their training needs and that the Selection Committee has sufficient time to properly evaluate the applicant's fit to the program. As such, the slots allotted for personal interviews and site visits are necessarily limited. Applicants who are invited for an interview will be notified by December 1st and are then advised to call the Internship Program at (405) 325-2700 to schedule their interview and site visit for December or early January.
